



Publication of The Case Managers' Chronicles - Overcoming Adversity Against All Odds



The book represents yet another significant milestone in the history of case management in Singapore. This publication heralds the critical role of CMSS as THE organization dedicated to support, grow and develop case management professionals in Singapore.

Over the past 2 decades, the role of case managers has grown and multiplied. It started off with developing and tracking clinical pathways, and then dealing with complex patients in hospitals who may pose potential discharge issues. They then became critical actors in developing and implementing disease management programmes. More recently, case managers have become agents of transitional care and care coordination.

Within the community health and social sectors, we also saw a concomitant increase of case managers to address the challenges of clients with long term care conditions compounded by social issues. Hence, it was just timely that in 2012, the CMSS was formed organically from a group of dedicated case

Basic Case Management Workshop



Together with my four of my colleagues, I attended the four days Basic Case Management Workshop, recently organized by the Case Management Society of Singapore and held at the Kwong Wai Sui Hospital. The course was well attended with 35 registered participants from the various health care sectors in Singapore. There were theoretical lectures, video shows and practice sessions. We were introduced to pertinent topics such as an Overview of the Singapore Healthcare System, Healthcare Financing Models in Singapore, Case Management Models and Concepts and the Standards of Practice for Case Management and Competency in Singapore, Transitional care, Tele Case Management and Advance Care Planning. These are all important topics which a case manager must be well versed in. Lastly there were sessions on case studies to allow us to practice the knowledge we gained during these sessions. Equipped with this knowledge and skills, especially the management of complex clients, we now better prepared to case manage our patients. Indeed the workshop also enable us to network with our fellow case managers who will link us to resources when we require assistance for our patients. There were also tea breaks and lunch provided during the training which allowed us to fulfil our basic needs. The Basic Case Management workshop is an Important training workshop for all who wish to pursue a career in case management.
